

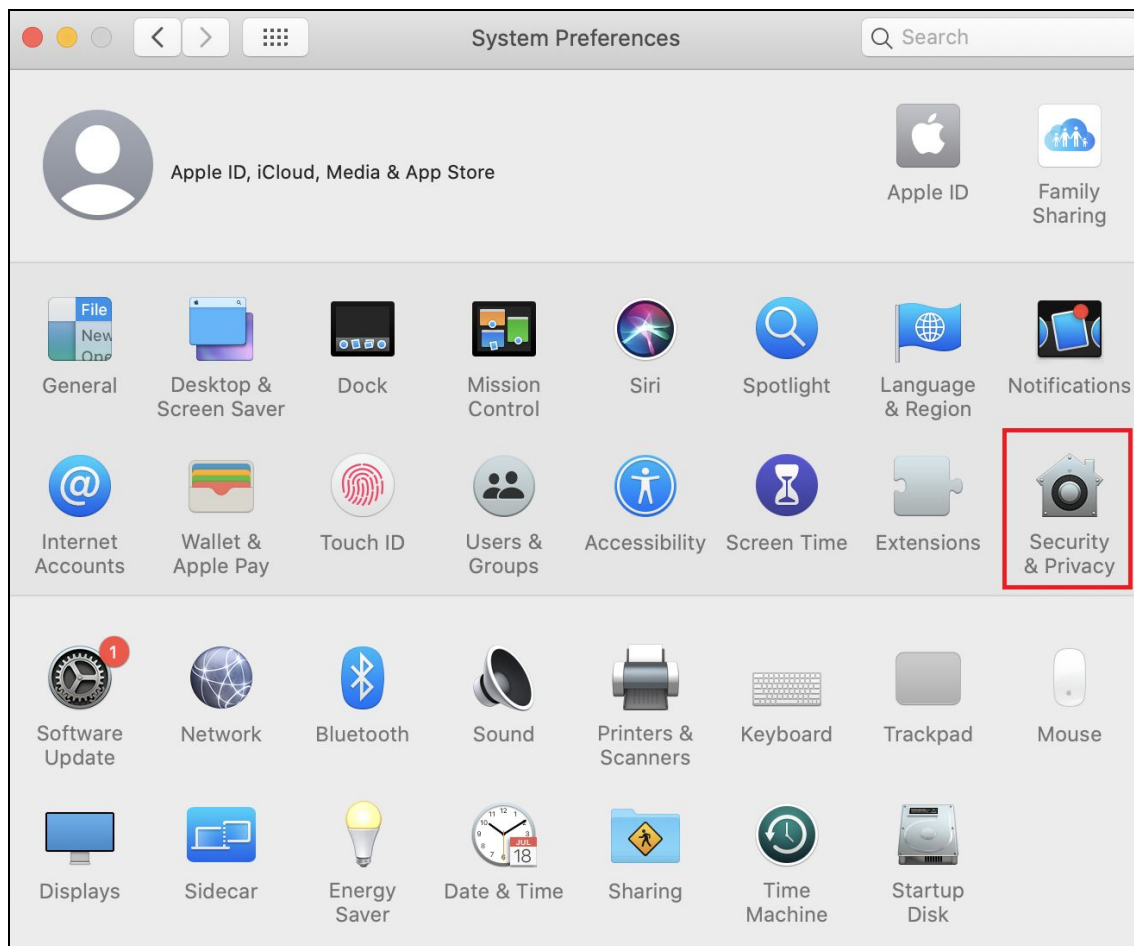
MSSND #3: Host-based Firewall Software

Enable firewalls

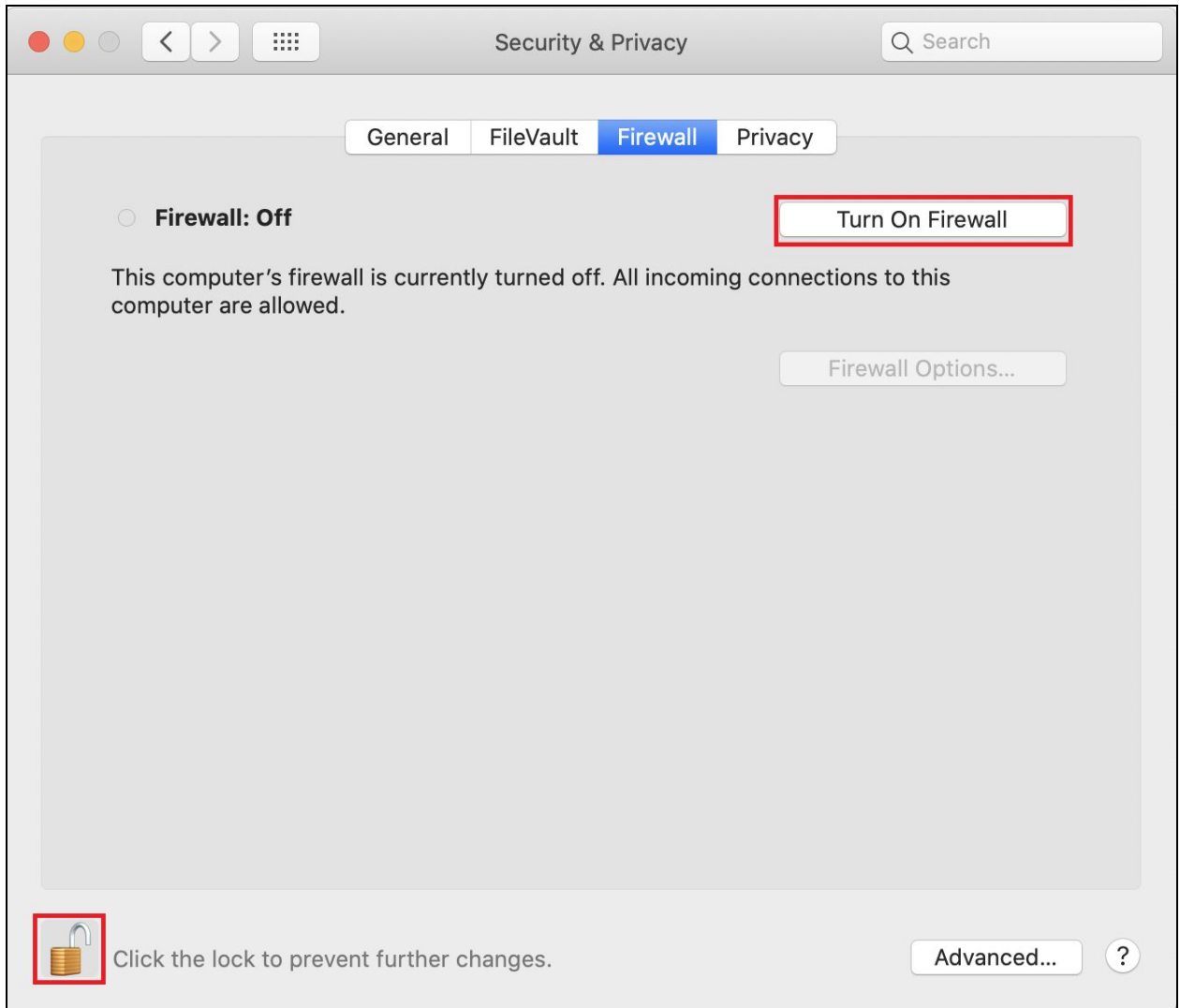

Instructions for turning on the built-in host-based firewall for your Mac device.

1. System Preferences > Security and Privacy




2. Firewall > Unlock with the lock in the lower left corner > Turn on Firewall



3. Firewall Options

- a. Block all incoming connections
- b. Enable stealth mode
- c. Others unchecked

Block all incoming connections
Blocks all incoming connections except those required for basic Internet services, such as DHCP, Bonjour, and IPSec.



The firewall will block all sharing services, such as file sharing, screen sharing, Messages Bonjour, and iTunes music sharing. If you want to allow sharing services, deselect the "Block all incoming connections" checkbox.

Automatically allow built-in software to receive incoming connections

Automatically allow downloaded signed software to receive incoming connections
Allows software signed by a valid certificate authority to provide services accessed from the network.

Enable stealth mode
Don't respond to or acknowledge attempts to access this computer from the network by test applications using ICMP, such as Ping.
